- STEP 1** Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition. Let motorcycle cool. Remove main fuse.

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
**STEP 3** Refer to PIC 2. Remove existing air cleaner assembly and hardware. Set it aside, it will not be reused. Ensure that the intake flange of the throttle body is clean and dry.

**STEP 4** Locate and disconnect the motorcycle's ignition coil connector.

*Note: Refer to your motorcycle's service manual for assistance.*

**STEP 5** Refer to PIC 3. Locate provided controller.

**STEP 6** Refer to PIC 4. Feed the controller's ignition coil connectors wire through an open slot of the frame, under the seat area.

**STEP 7** Refer to PIC 4. Connect the controller's ignition coil connectors (male and female) to the motorcycle's connectors that were disconnected in Step 4.

**STEP 8** Refer to PIC 5 and 6. Unfasten the screw secured to the battery's negative terminal, and set any connected wires safely away from the battery. Locate the controller's Negative Wire Ring Terminal. Fasten the controller's negative ring terminal, and any other wires that were previously connected, to the battery's negative .

*Note: If applicable, feed the controller's wire with the terminal ring through the frame of the motorcycle to gain access to the battery, and prevent future pinching on the wire.*

**STEP 9** Refer to PIC 7. Feed the controller's 3-pin connector wire through an open slot of the frame, under the seat area. Position the wire over the top of the rear cylinder head and down and behind the throttle body. Do not tie these wires off to the frame or other cables just yet.

**STEP 10** Set the whole controller within a safe open space located in the frame under the seat area.

*Note: The 6-pin connector, located on the opposite side from all of the other wires, does not connect to anything. It can be wrapped in electrical tape and tucked off to the side with the rest of the module.*

**STEP 11** Refer to PIC 8. Locate and install two (2) provided Breather Bolts to the cylinder heads.

**TORQUE VALUE FOR BREATHER BOLTS:**  
22-24 FT-LBS (29.8-32.5 NM)

**STEP 12** Refer to PIC 9. Locate the provided Breather Manifold and Front Adhesive Gasket. Remove and discard the adhesive backing from the included Gasket; align it with the mounting holes and press it into place.

**STEP 13** Refer to PIC 10. Locate provided back adhesive gasket. Remove and discard the adhesive backing from the included gasket; on the back side of the breather manifold align it with the mounting holes and press it into place.



**STEP 14** Refer to PIC 11 and 12. Locate provided Left and Right Breather Hoses and four (4) Spring Clamps. Place a clamp on each end of each breather hose. Connect breather hoses to the ports on the back of the breather manifold. Secure the hoses using the attached clamps.

*Note: The longer hose fastens to the left side of the breather manifold, and the shorter hose fastens to the right side.*



**STEP 15** Refer to PIC 13 and 14. Align the breather manifold assembly and connect the breather hoses to the breather bolts. Ensure that the hoses are free of kinks or tight bends. Secure the ends of the two (2) hoses with the attached hose clamps.

**STEP 16** Refer to FIG 1. Locate the provided Hypercharger ES Air Cleaner assembly. Dismantle the air cleaner assembly. Make note as to how it is assembled, it will help for reassembly.

- Remove two (2) outside edge screws from cone, and loosen the two (2) inside edge screws
- Remove the cover by pushing it to the left
- Remove two (2) screws and two (2) washers attaching the air filter
- Remove air filter from backer plate assembly




**STEP 17** Refer to PIC 15. Locate provided three (3) 1/4-20 x 1-1/4\" Flat Head Socket Cap Screws. Align the Backer Plate mounting holes with the Breather Manifold. Insert the screws into the mounting holes of the Backer Plate and fasten it to the manifold. Fully tighten hardware.

**TORQUE VALUE FOR BACKPLATE SCREWS:**  
40-60 IN-LBS (4.5-6.8 NM)

**STEP 18** Refer to PIC 16 and 17. Locate the Air Filter and two (2) Button Head Cap Screws and (2) Washers that were removed in Step 16. Place the washers onto the screws. Align the air filter mounting holes with the Backer Plate stand offs. Fasten the Air Filter to the Backer Plate by using the screw and washer combos. Fully tighten hardware.



**STEP 19** Refer to PIC 18 and 19. Locate the Cover. Be aware that there is a tab located on the left back side of the cover that will align with a notch on the left back side of the backer plate.



**STEP 20** Refer to PIC 20 and 21. Slide the cover over the air filter assembly starting from the back side of the bike and pushing it towards the front of the bike. Be sure the tab of the cover is seated properly in the notch of the backer plate. Push the cover forward. There should be a little gap between the cover and the cone of the assembly.



**STEP 21** Refer to PIC 22. Locate the two (2) socket head cap screws that were removed in Step 16. Insert the screws into the outside edge holes of the cone. As you tighten the screws the cover should pull forward, closing the gap between the cone and cover. Fully tighten all four (4) screws in the cone.



**STEP 22** Refer to PIC 23. Connect the Hypercharger's servo motor connector with the controller's 3-pin connector. Use the provided 6" cable ties to fasten the controller's wires to other secure cables or the frame of the bike to secure the wires out of the way.

**STEP 23** Reinstall main fuse. Turn ignition on and test newly installed Hypercharger ES air cleaner. Turn ignition off.



**STEP 24** Reinstall the seat, and battery cover if applicable.

Kuryakyn warrants that any Kuryakyn products sold hereunder, shall be free of defects in materials & workmanship for a period of one (1) year from the date of purchase by the consumer excepting the following provisions:

1. Kuryakyn shall have no obligation in the event the customer is unable to provide a receipt showing the date the customer purchased the product(s).
2. The product must be properly installed, maintained & operated under normal conditions.
3. Kuryakyn shall not be liable for any consequential & incidental damages, including labor & paint, resulting from failure of a Kuryakyn product, failure to deliver, delay in delivery, delivery in nonconforming condition, or for any breach of contract or duty between Kuryakyn & a customer.
4. Kuryakyn products are often intended for use in specific applications. Kuryakyn makes no warranty if a Kuryakyn product is used in applications other than intended.
5. Kuryakyn electrical products are warranted for one (1) year from the date of purchase by the consumer. L.E.D.'s contained in components of Kuryakyn products will be warranted for defects in materials & workmanship for 3 years from the date of purchase whereas all other components shall be warranted for one (1) year.
6. All warranty claims must be directed to the place of purchase. Merchandise sold through internet auction sites or any other unauthorized reseller shall not carry a Kuryakyn warranty. If unsure, please contact the place of purchase to verify they are an authorized Kuryakyn reseller.

#### RETURN POLICY

Merchandise determined to be defective may be returned up to one year from the date of purchase. Returns must be processed through original seller. Returned merchandise for any other reason other than warranty claims must be in like new condition & subject to a 20% restocking fee. All returns are subject to inspection for determination of full or partial credit. Any returned part that shows evidence of being used or installed contrary to manufacturer's instructions, &/or subjected to improper handling, packaging or return shipping by the customer, will not be eligible for exchange, refund or warranty consideration. All returned electrical items will be inspected & tested. If electrical item is deemed functional, no credit will be issued & item will be returned. All sales are final on discontinued or closeout merchandise.

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
