

Read all instructions carefully and completely before installing your new slip-on mufflers

- 1. Remove the stock muffler mounting bolts and save. Loosen the stock muffler clamps then pull both mufflers (in unison) from the headpipes. The stock clamps will not be reused.
- 2. Remove gasket from muffler crossover slip and install into the supplied rear slip-on muffler. If needed, a replacement gasket can be purchased through your dealer (HD Part #65830-03).
- 3. Slide the supplied 27-61MSC clamps over the slip-on mufflers and position them as shown in Figure 1.
- 4. NOTE: THE MUFFLER WITH THE COBRA LOGO WILL ALWAYS BE THE REAR CYLINDER. Connect the crossover slips together and slide both mufflers onto the headpipes in unison (reverse the order of removal) until the mounting holes align.
- 5. Fasten the mufflers using the stock mounting bolts in the same manner as stock but do not tighten. Verify that the gap, where the mufflers meet the stock heatshields, is similar to the gap the stock mufflers allotted.
- Check all clearances and alignments, then tighten the clamps. (NOTE: If the muffler clamps are slid past the slots on the slip collar the clamps will not tighten the mufflers properly). Tighten all loose bolts to factory specifications.
- 7. NOTE: The exhaust tips may be loosened and oriented to various positions for different visual effects.
