STEP 1

Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition. Let motorcycle cool.



STEP 2

Refer to PIC 1. Locate the Left and Right Adjustable Passenger Peg Mounts. Remove the six screws as shown; set the screws aside, they will be reused.

NOTE: The Adjustable Passenger Peg mounts are labeled "RH" (RIGHT (BRAKE)- SIDE) and "LH" (LEFT (CLUTCH)-SIDE), respectively.

STEP 3 TYPICAL INSTALLATION: REFER TO PICS 2 AND 3.

> Locate the included Stop Bushings; install them on the left and right bottom mount tabs. The tall edge of the Stop Bushing goes against the top mount/pivot arm assembly.

ON '10-'14 TRIKE APPLICATIONS: REFER TO PICS 2 THROUGH 6.

Locate the included Stop Bushing marked "TRIKES"; install it on the brake-side (right) bottom-mount; install one of the other Stop Bushings on the clutch-side (left) bottom mount; ensure the taller edge goes against the top mount/pivot arm assembly.

STEP 4 As shown in PIC 7, place the top mount/pivot arm assembly over the footboard support (with pivot arm facing outward). Check for proper clearance between the top mount/pivot arm assembly and the footboard.

STEP 5 As shown in PIC 8, secure the bottom mount to the top assembly with the screws removed in STEP 2. The three shorter screws = clutch-side (left); the two long and one short screw = brake-side (right); tighten the fasteners evenly; do not over-tighten.



STEP 6 Install the included foot pegs on the pivot arms with the supplied fasteners. Leave loose for now.

STEP 7

Adjust the peg pads to the most comfortable position with the arm in the forward position. Tighten the fastener securing the peg to the arm.

STEP 8

To adjust the position of the pivot arm, move the locking knob out of the locked position and rotate the pivot arm to the desired position. Move the knob back into the locked position.
