

Mounting Suggestions: 2007-2011 Yamaha V-Star 1300 & 1300 Tourer Two-Piece Seat



Removal of Stock Two-Piece Seat:

Baseplate Features:

The two-piece, marine grade fiberglass baseplate directly replaces the stock seat. Rubber bumpers are positioned to minimize vibration and protect the frame and fender.

- 1. Insert ignition key into the left side cover and turn counterclockwise to unlock front solo seat.
- 2. Lift front of solo up and off the frame.



- 3. The stock rear seat 's two 6mm mounti ng bolts are now accessible. Use a 10mm socket with extension to reach bolts and then remove.
- 4. With bolts removed, slide rear seat up and then forwar d to di sengage seat rear bracket from frame.

Mounting of Mustang Seat:

Mustang's seat installs just like the Yamaha factory seat.

- 1. Place the passenger seat on the fender, then slide it back to engage seat's rear bracket into the fender's U-bracket. Install Yamaha's 6mm bolts to the front fender bracket. Tighten with a 10mm socket.
- Turn the ignition key in the left side cover counterclockwise t o unl ock the front lat ch mechanism.
- 3. Align the solo seat's re ar bracket with t he fender receiver. Slide seat all the way back and push the nose of the seat down until a click is heard. The seat is now locked.
