 Read all instructions carefully and completely before installing your new slip-on mufflers Remove the saddlebags carefully. Remove and save the mounting hardware securing the mufflers to the brackets. Loosen the stock muffler clamps then pull the stock mufflers free from the headpipes. The stock clamps will not be reused. Slide the supplied 27-61MSC clamps over the slip-on mufflers and position them as shown in Figure 1 with the hex head facing inward and towards the ground. Slide the mufflers onto the headpipes until the mounting holes align. Note: Indents on mufflers will face inward. Fasten the mufflers using the stock mounting hardware in the same manner as stock but do not tighten. From the rear, rotate the mufflers as needed so they are level with the ground and parallel with each other. Verify that the gap, where the mufflers meet the stock heatshields, is similar to the gap the stock mufflers allotted. Check all clearances and alignments then tighten the mounting bolts to factory specifications. Tighten the mufflers properly. Reinstall saddlebags carefully. <i>IMPORTANT:</i> Before starting your engine remove all fingerprints from all exhaust surfaces. To clean your black exhaust system use a liquid based soap detergent, such as dishwashing soap applied with a soft cloth and rinse with clean water. Note: Avoid abrasive cleaning methods such as granular or dry cleansers, simple green, scotch-brite or 			
steel wool pads. Abrasives may breach the coating and shorten life.
